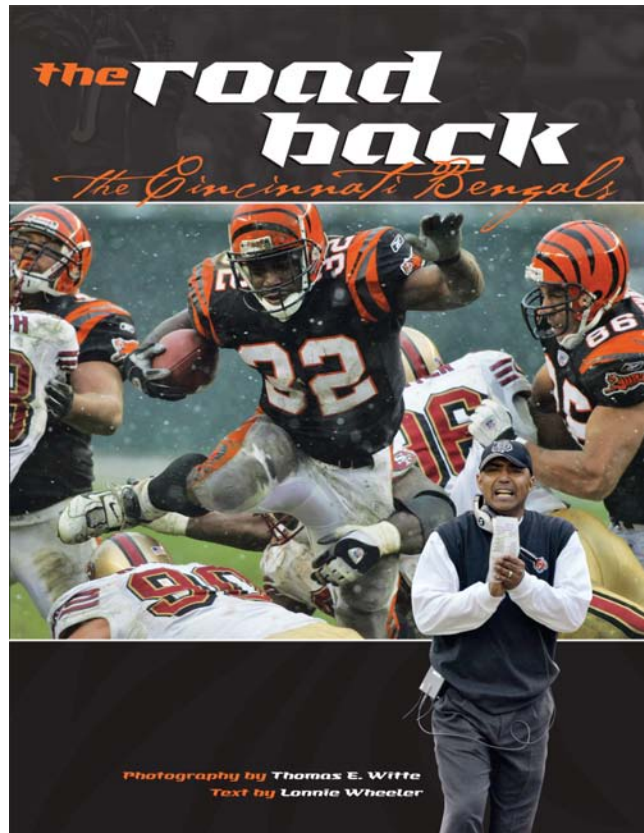
The Cincinnati Bengals
